

October 30 – November 3, 2017 Brussels & The Hague

#### **OVERVIEW:**

The Pacific Council invites you to participate in an exclusive 5-day visit to Belgium and the Netherlands. This delegation will consist of visits to **Brussels in Belgium and The Hague in the Netherlands**, where we anticipate meetings with the European Parliament, European Council, NATO, the U.N.'s International Court of Justice, and the International Criminal Court.

The Pacific Council's Country Dialogues bring participants closer to the internal workings of countries that figure prominently in world affairs, through high-level meetings with senior business, cultural, and political leaders. Our delegations aim to foster a deeper understanding of international affairs and to strengthen global discourse through exchanges with key political and cultural stakeholders. As ambassadors of the Pacific Council on International Policy, participants have the opportunity to represent the West Coast's key interests and concerns in meetings with local leaders while gaining exposure to the rich cultural heritage of each country they visit.

#### **KEY INFORMATION:**

- The registration fee is inclusive of luxury hotel accommodations at <u>Hotel Amigo</u> from Oct 29 Nov 2 (four nights) in Brussels and at <u>Hotel Des Indes</u> in The Hague from Nov 2 4; all ground transportation; airport transfers; all meals; staff support; and all logistical arrangements pertaining to the visit. - Airfare is not included in the registration pricing. Delegates will need to arrange for their own flights to Brussels, Belgium and from Amsterdam, Netherlands.
- Delegates are expected to arrive in Brussels by the evening of Sunday, October 29. The trip will begin the morning of Monday, October 30 and will run through the early evening of Friday, November 3. Delegates will depart Saturday, November 4.
- A 50% deposit to reserve your space is due by **Friday**, **July 14**.
- The registration fee is due in full <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 4</u>.
